 The diagnostics industry in India is currently valued at \$4 bn. The share of the organized sector is almost 25% in this segment (15% in labs and 10% in radiology).

 The health-tech market comprises of following segments - telemedicine, e-pharmacy, fitness, wellness, healthcare IT, analytics, home healthcare and personal health management.

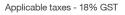
